In order to enhance the overall safety and efficiency of the Fair, new measures regarding custom-built stands have been implemented. Please pay attention to the summary as follow and refer to section 4 of the Exhibitors' Manual for details.

Otherwise, a late charge of HK\$3,000 (US\$400) will be charged to the Exhibitor or its appointed contractor. Exhibitors must accept full responsibility for the safety of the Stand, as Construction Sites (Safety) Regulations (Chapter 59) is applicable.

An Authorized Person can either be a Registered Architect (AP-List I), or a Registered Structural Engineer (AP-List II), or a Registered Building Surveyor (AP-list III). An Authorized Person is legally defined in the HKSAR Buildings Ordinance Chapter 123. #### Fire Services Certificate

In compliance with the Temporary Places of Public Entertainment Licence (TPPE) application for Fairs/Fetes/Exhibitions (small scale), no decoration of a readily combustible nature shall be permitted. A documentary proof of compliance for all custom-built stands with the use of combustible materials for false ceilings, partitions or wall furnishings, draperies and curtains shall conform to any standard acceptable to the Director of Fire Services; or shall be brought up to any of those standards by treating with a fire retardant paint or solution acceptable to Director of Fire Services. In the latter case, the work shall be carried out by a Class 2
